Note 1) Attachments to the application for the FVG sport fishing licence for PEOPLE OF AGE with at least 2 Yearly Authorisations in the years 2013/2017

- Non-certified copy of an identity document and of the tax code of the subscriber;
- Payment of the cost of issuing the FVG licence, which amounts to € 14.00 (if the licence is sent by post, the payment must be € 22.00) payable via the PagoPA system after obtaining the relevant pre-printed form from the ETPI Licencing Office;
- Payment of the stamp duty of € 32.00 (€ 16.00 for the application and € 16.00 for the fishing document) by means of form F23 of the Revenue Agency (Agenzia delle Entrate), the facsimile of which is available at the ETPI Licencing Offices or, alternatively, purchase of two € 16.00 paper revenue stamps or a single € 32.00 one to be applied on this application.

Note 2) General information

Pursuant to Art. 38 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000, the form must be signed by the applicant aged 18 or over in the presence of the ETPI employee in charge, or signed and submitted, together with a non-certified copy of an identity document and the taxpayer's code, by a third party or by post. **The veracity of the declarations made is subject to verification.**

Note 3) Information on the FVG sport fishing licence

Duration of the licence: The FVG licence is of unlimited duration and is valid with payment of the fee.

Trips and fishing activity: According to the current ETPI sport fishing calendar and its rules.

Fee: It is possible to pay the fee via APPesca.FVG or with the payment form pre-printed by the Licencing Offices or Issuing Points.

Use of the FVG Licence: On each trip, the fisher will bring with him/her the FVG sport fishing licence, the fee receipt, the document for recording the trips and the catch and a valid identification document. If the fisher uses APPesca.FVG, possession of the licence and payment of the fee can be proved directly from the App.

- **Purpose of processing:** The data provided to ETPI to obtain documents for sport fishing registrations are processed in accordance with the provisions in force for the purposes of the procedure for which they were requested and are used exclusively for that purpose and for the institutional purposes of the Ente Tutela Patrimonio Ittico. Please note that ETPI, as a Public Administration, does not have to ask for consent to the processing and the processing is lawful if it is necessary to comply with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject or when it is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in connection with the exercise of public powers vested in the Controller.

- **Retention period** of personal data: The data provided is stored by ETPI for an unlimited period, for statistical purposes.

- **The data subject has the right** to ask the Data Controller for access to his/her personal data and to rectify or erase it or to restrict or oppose its processing, as well as the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.

- **The data subject is obliged** to provide data for the application to be accepted.
