**Notes:**

1) Payment of the stamp duty of € 16.00 may be made by means of form [F23](#) of the Revenue Agency (Agenzia delle Entrate), a receipt for which must be attached to the application for admission to the examination (for applications to be sent by email). Alternatively, it is possible to purchase a paper stamp of € 16.00, which **must** be affixed in the space provided on the application form, and which **must be delivered** in the original to the [ETPI Licensing Offices](#).

2) Pursuant to Art. 38 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000, the form must be signed by the parent/guardian in the presence of the designated ETPI employee, or signed and submitted, together with an uncertified copy of an identity document of the signatory and the minor, also by a third party, by fax to 0432/551299 or by email to [etpi@regione.fvg.it](mailto:etpi@regione.fvg.it)

**The veracity of the declarations made is subject to random verification.**

3) A candidate who passes the examination and is **14 years** of age or older may receive a fishing licence by making the following payments:

- Payment of a stamp duty of € 16.00, which can be made by means of form [F23](#) of the Revenue Agency (Agenzia delle Entrate), the payment receipt for which must be sent by email to [licenze@etpi.fvg.it](mailto:licenze@etpi.fvg.it) or, alternatively, upon purchase of the € 16.00 paper stamp, which must be delivered in the original at the [ETPI Licensing Offices](#);
- Payment of the amount of € 14.00, to which the amount of the annual fishing fee may possibly be added, via the PagoPA system, upon request of the relevant pre-printed form from the Licensing Office.

## FVG SPORT FISHING LICENCE EXAMINATION

**Target group:** The examination is reserved for those wishing to obtain the FVG sport fishing licence who are at least 13 years old.

**Mandatory requirements for admission** to the examination: In order to take the examination, you must:

- Have reached the age of 13 on the date set for the written test.
- Have submitted the application for admission to the examination to ETPI by the deadline and in the prescribed manner.

The examination can be taken on reaching the age of 13, but it is possible to apply for a fishing licence from the age of 14.

**Deadline and method for submitting the application for admission:** The application for admission to the examination must be received on the appropriate form, duly completed in all its parts. The form can be downloaded from [www.etpi.fvg.it](http://www.etpi.fvg.it), or picked up at the [ETPI's Licensing Offices](#). The application for admission must be submitted, together with a copy of the minor's identity document and tax code and a copy of the parent/guardian's identity document, either directly by the person concerned or through a third party at the [ETPI's Licensing Offices](#), sent by fax to 0432/551299 or by email to the address [etpi@regione.fvg.it](mailto:etpi@regione.fvg.it). Applications received up to three days before the examination date will be considered accepted unless the maximum number of admissible registrations set by Etpi for the examination sessions has already been exceeded. It should be noted that the examination session will take place if at least five applications are received. Candidates who do not pass the examination, without submitting a new application, may participate in subsequent examination sessions within the same year by notifying ETPI via email. Candidates who did not pass the examination during the year may submit a new application to participate in the examination sessions held in the following year.

The subject matters of the **examination** cover the following topics:

- (a) Elements of the aquatic ecosystem: food chain, ecological pyramid, population structure and ecology, competition, predation and migration.
- (b) Biology, ecology and recognition of the main autochthonous and allochthonous fish species in the inland waters of Friuli Venezia Giulia.
- (c) Elements of fish management: releases, combating invasive exotic species, land and watercourse zoning, harvest planning and management.
- (d) Sport fishing regulation.
- (e) Main techniques, gear and bait used in fishing and rules of conduct.

**Examination:** The sport fishing licence examination consists of a written test, in the form of a quiz, with multiple-choice answers, and a possible interview. The written test, lasting a maximum of sixty minutes, consists of a combination of forty questions. Each question corresponds to three alternative answers, only one of which is correct. Each correct answer is awarded two points; each incorrect answer is awarded zero points; each non-answer subtracts one point. Participation in preparatory courses for passing the examination, carried out by sports clubs, associations and voluntary organisations on the list referred to in article 17, par. 2 of RL 42/2017 awards six points. The pass mark is achieved when seventy points are reached. Candidates scoring between sixty-two and sixty-nine points are admitted to an interview, lasting a maximum of fifteen minutes, to be held on the same day as the written test. The candidate passes the interview if he/she demonstrates sufficient competence, in the opinion of the Commission, in the subjects being examined.

**Outcome of the examination:** The Examination Committee, appointed by the Director General of ETPI, makes the final pass or fail decision for each candidate examined. The result is communicated to the candidate at the end of the test.

- **Retention period** of personal data: The data provided is stored by ETPI for an unlimited period, for statistical purposes.

- **The data subject has the right** to ask the Data Controller for access to his/her personal data and to rectify or erase it or to restrict or oppose its processing, as well as the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.

- **The data subject is obliged** to provide data for the application to be accepted.
